Our last event of the Spring semester is also our biggest: the Florida International Summit 2012. The statewide summit, cohosted by UCF and FSU, is a Florida Network for Global Studies forum centered on the topic of “Technology, Society and Innovation in an Era of Globalization.”

The program includes three featured-speakers and two panels of experts. Stand-alone speakers include Senior Editor of *TechCrunch*, Sarah Lacy; former Chief Judge in the World Trade Organization, James Bacchus; and Director of the Hybrid Reality Institute, Ayesha Khanna. The first panel, “Africa’s Technology and Business Environments,” features Ernest Jones, Director of Worldwide Sales for Tivoli Software and Anita Spring, Professor Emeritus at the University of Florida. The second panel, “Europe’s Innovative Global Reach,” features Tim Cullen, Director of the Oxford Programme on Negotiation and Ning Wang, Project Leader for the Wermland Chamber of Commerce, Sweden.

This registration-only event takes place on Thursday, April 12, 2012, from 8:30 a.m. to 3:00 p.m, with a light breakfast and lunch provided.
