## Event Spotlight

In late October, UCF hosted its annual forum on “Women and Leadership: A Global Perspective.” Six years ago, the Global Perspectives Office, in partnership with Lt. Gen. (Ret.) Jay Garner, sought to examine and promote examples of women and leadership in the global community. The inaugural forum asked a simple question: “What does leadership look like for women in an evolving world?” Each year since then, a different theme has highlighted other facets of women and leadership, such as “Breaking Barriers” and “Ethics and Human Rights,” to name a few.

This year, we heard from three women and their experiences with “Reaching Out to Touch the World.” While the panelists’ stories were unique, they shared the common thread of reaching beyond their borders – both personal and geographic – and developing as leaders through service to others. International humanitarian Alison Thompson, along with Fulbright foreign language teaching assistants, Bahia Braktia from Algeria and Ayumi Yamamoto from Japan, made presentations. Maria Cristina Santana, director of UCF’s Women’s Studies Program, moderated the forum.
