Carmon is an Israeli-American journalist and commentator who focuses on women, politics and culture. She was named one of Forbes' "30 under 30" in media and is also featured as a face of young feminism in *New York* magazine. Westbrook, having held a number of leadership positions including her current title of SGA President, brings a local perspective to the forum.

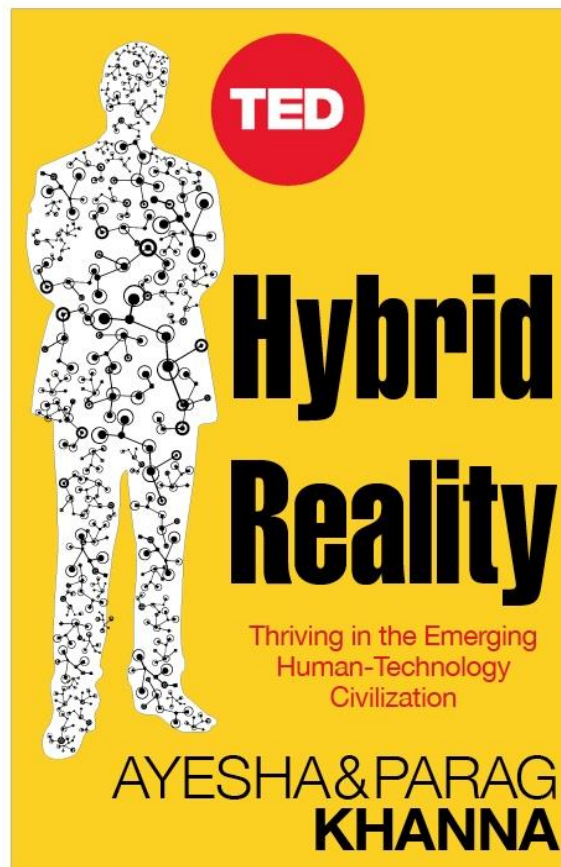
