Interns are eligible to receive course credit for their time and effort.



Internships require an applicant to have a minimum 3.0 GPA, to be at least a Junior, and to submit an application and resume by April 18, 2014. Interns are expected to have a weekly time commitment of approximately 12 to 15 hours, with 10 hours dedicated to time in the office.
