Every year, Global Perspectives (GP) is proud to partner with UCF's International Services Center to help present the kickoff event to International Education Week, the International Breakfast. This year, before the audience was entertained with student dance and musical performances, three representatives from the American Security Project (ASP) presented on global climate change and its effects on national and international human security.



After Andrew Holland, ASP's Senior Fellow for Energy and Climate, provided an overview of the science behind climate change, Lt. Gen. Donald Kerrick (Ret.) (pictured above) and Lt. Gen. Claudia Kennedy (Ret.) discussed their personal and professional experiences with climate change and its influence on human security.
