## Event Spotlight: Tackling Terrorism



On Monday, July 20, UCF's Intelligence Community Center for Academic Excellence and GP welcome you to attend a Speaker Series event, "Perspectives on Terrorism from the Academy and the Field." There, a panel of experts from academia and the government will discuss terrorism, counterterrorism and whether current efforts are working.

Panelists include Dr. Sebastian Gorka, the Major General Matthew C. Horner Distinguished Chair of Military Theory at the Marine Corps University, and Adrienne George, the National Counterterrorism Center's Domestic Representative in Miami, among others.

The roundtable format of the event allows for and promotes questions from the audience and discussion among panelists. This event is open to the public. It will take place at 1:00 p.m. in the Dean's Conference Room, in the College of Sciences Building, at UCF.



In addition to research and office assistance, interns and fellows help facilitate public events that GP organizes each semester. Every fellowship program awards \$500 for the semester with the exception of the Lawrence J. Chastang Global Fellowship, which provides \$1,000. Internships require an applicant to have a minimum 3.0 GPA, to be at least a Junior and to submit an application and resume by July 31, 2015. Applicants for fellowships must also be a Junior or higher and submit a resume and application, but must also have a minimum 3.5 GPA, two letters of reference, a one-page personal statement, a 5-10 page writing sample and an unofficial transcript. Interns and fellows are expected to have a weekly time commitment of approximately 15 hours, with 10 hours dedicated to time in the office.
