### FELLOWSHIP PROGRAM BENEFITS

Fellows receive an award of up to \$42,000 annually for two years toward tuition and related expenses for a master's degree, mentoring, and two funded summer internships. Fellows join the State Department or USAID Foreign Service upon successful completion of their programs, embarking on a uniquely rewarding career of service.

### ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

- Must be a U.S. citizen at time of application.
- Plan to start graduate school in fall 2022 for a two year master's degree in an area of relevance to the Foreign Service at a U.S.-based institution.
- Must have a cumulative grade point average of 3.2 or higher on a 4.0 scale at the time of application.

### RANGEL INTERNATIONAL AFFAIRS SUMMER ENRICHMENT PROGRAM (SEP)

Six-week summer program designed to help undergraduate students explore and prepare for careers in international affairs.

- **Eligibility:** U.S. citizenship, full-time undergraduate student with at least sophomore status, and a 3.2 GPA.
